
Remote Controller Function

- (1) ON
- (2) OFF
- (3) Adjust the brightness under the static color mode. (5 steps increasing 5 steps reducing).

Adjust the speed of the color changing under the dynamic mode.

(5 steps increasing 5 steps reducing).

- (4) Direct acess to 16 permix colors (Brightness is adjustable)
- (5) Static color mode: Neutral white
- (6) Dynamic mode: Seven colors changing in jumping style.
- (7) Dynamic mode: Seven colors changing in gradualness style.(Fast)
- (8) Dynamic mode: Seven colors changing in gradualness style.(Slow)



Safety notes

- -The power cable may not be shortened.
